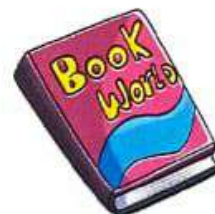

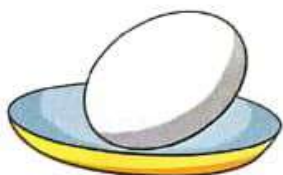

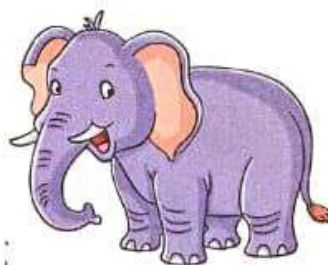
'An' is used before a noun which begins with vowel sound, a, e, i, o, u.
